## Hebrews 10:35

<sup>35</sup> Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward.



## Hebrews 10:36

<sup>36</sup> For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised.

## Hebrews 10:37

<sup>37</sup> For, “Yet a little while, and the coming one will come and will not delay;



## Hebrews 10:38

<sup>38</sup> but my righteous one shall live by faith, and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him.”

## Hebrews 10:39

<sup>39</sup> But we are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls.



# Hebrews 11:1

<sup>1</sup> Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

# Hebrews 11:2

<sup>2</sup> For by it the people of old  
received their commendation.



## Hebrews 11:3

<sup>3</sup> By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

<sup>24</sup> Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came.

<sup>25</sup> So the other disciples told him, “We have seen the Lord.” But he said to them, “Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of

<sup>25</sup> the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe.”



## John 20:26

<sup>26</sup> Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them.

## John 20:26

<sup>26</sup> Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, “Peace be with you.”



## John 20:27

<sup>27</sup> Then he said to Thomas, “Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe.”

## John 20:28

<sup>28</sup> Thomas answered him, “My Lord and my God!”



## John 20:29

<sup>29</sup> Jesus said to him, “Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.”

## John 20:30

<sup>30</sup> Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;



## John 20:31

<sup>31</sup> but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
