Jeremiah 8:4-9  
Jeremiah 8:20-22

## Jeremiah 8:4-5

<sup>4</sup> “You shall say to them, Thus says the LORD: When men fall, do they not rise again? If one turns away, does he not return? <sup>5</sup> Why then has this people turned away in perpetual backsliding? They hold fast to deceit; they refuse to return.



## Jeremiah 8:6

<sup>6</sup> I have paid attention and listened, but they have not spoken rightly; no man relents of his evil, saying, 'What have I done?' Everyone turns to his own course, like a horse plunging headlong into battle.

## Jeremiah 8:7

<sup>7</sup> Even the stork in the heavens knows her times, and the turtledove, swallow, and crane keep the time of their coming, but my people know not the rules of the LORD.



## Jeremiah 8:

<sup>8</sup> “How can you say, ‘We are wise, and the law of the LORD is with us’? But behold, the lying pen of the scribes has made it into a lie.

## Jeremiah 8:9

<sup>9</sup>The wise men shall be put to shame; they shall be dismayed dismayed and taken; behold, they have rejected the word of the LORD, so what wisdom is in them?



## Jeremiah 8:20-21

<sup>20</sup> “The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved.” <sup>21</sup> For the wound of the daughter of my people is my heart wounded; I mourn, and dismay has taken hold on me.

## Jeremiah 8:22

<sup>22</sup> Is there no balm in Gilead? Is there no physician there? Why then has the health of the daughter of my people not been restored?
